

-MB202 BIRDING IN THE DELTA DEL PARANA AND ENTRE RIOS-

PROGRAM: 2 Days / 1 Night

<u>Day 1</u>: Pick up at 6:00 hs in a prearranged location and drive to Villa Paranacito, at the northern edge of the Parana delta (2 hs). After lunch we will be birding in dry woodlands around Ceibas town. This is the best birding site near Buenos Aires; a well-known place for birders, which it was surveyed for the last 30 years. Normally on a spring day the total bird list here is over one hundred species. <u>Overnight</u>: Hotel in Ceibas



<u>Day 2:</u> Another morning in the Ceibas region. Today we drive along open meadows and marshlands looking for a different set of birds. This mix of habitats is the key to high regional diversity. **Return to Buenos Aires city at about 19:00 hs.**





Birds: Southern Screamer, Ringed Teal, Long-winged Harrier, Giant Wood-Rail, Gilded Sapphire, Spotwinged Pigeon, Picui Ground-Dove, Ash-coloured Cuckoo, Checkered Woodpecker, White-fronted Woodpecker, Scimitar-billed Woodcreeper, Stripecrowned Spinetail, Freckle-breasted Thornbird, Little Thornbird. Brown Cacholote, Curve-billed Reedhaunter. Lark-like Brushrunner. Firewoodgathered, Short-billed Canastero, Stripe-crowned Spinetail, Sulphur-bearded Spinetail, Chotoy Spinetail, Tufted Tit-Spinetail, Rufous-capped Antshrike, Suiriri Flycatcher, White Monjita, Many-coloured Rush-Tyrant, Xenopsaris, Spectacled Tyrant, Sayaca Tanager, Long-tailed Reed-Finch, Black-and-rufous Warbling-Finch, Golden-billed Saltator, Grayish Saltator, Great Pampa-Finch, Red-crested Cardinal, Brown-and-yellow Marshbird, Scarlet-headed Blackbird, Solitary Cacique.
